Fourth year student Cara Reitz had the opportunity to travel to Haiti on a surgical mission trip with Dr. Andrew Rosenthal and a medical team from Memorial Regional and Baptist Hospitals. Dr. Rosenthal is the Associate Director of Trauma Services at MRH. They worked at Double Harvest, a medical facility one hour outside of Port-Au-Prince.

Upon arrival the patients were already lined up outside the door, many having traveled great distances to have a chance to be evaluated. Patients were triaged in order of medical urgency. Cara and the team spent upwards of 16 hours each day in the OR. Together, the team performed 43 surgeries in four days. In their rare spare time, the team had the chance to see the self-sustainable farm connected to the compound, and do a little tarantula hunting (see picture below).

Cara is "grateful to have had the opportunity to work with such gracious patients from a truly unique culture, and to have been part of a team so dedicated to giving back to others. " She looks forward to pursuing similar mission trips in her own career.

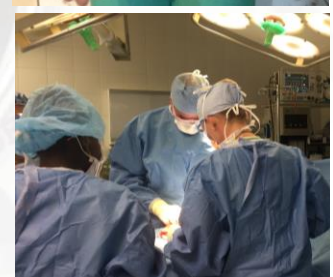


CASE REPORT

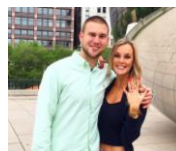
